With delightful aromas of ripe fruit and marzipan. Soft and mellow, with mouthfilling flavours of apricot, nectarine and almonds.

A top quality Pinot, dry, crisp, yet aromatic & fruity.

Produced by the De Bortoli family, established in 1938. A delicious new wave Aussie Chardonnay with flavours of peach and nectarine and a citrusy zest.

Packed full of fruit, with a distinctive rich pink hue and delightful strawberry aromas, dangerously easy drinking. Made by Foncalieu, one of the best cooperatives in the South of France who are renowned for producing great value wines.

12. Pinot Grigio Blush, La Delfina 3.75 5.25 7.25 21.95 Italy

This elegant Pinot Grigio Blush comes from grapes grown in the North East Italy. With delicate aromas of strawberry and raspberry.

Franschhoek Cellar, Stone Bridge Pinotage 24.95 Western Cape, South Africa This Pinotage is vibrant ruby in colour with mulberry and plum aromas and hints of chocolate and spire on the nose. 24.95 22. Magnifico, Primitivo di Manduria Puglia, Italy Made from Primitivo grapes in the little town of Manduria in Puglia. As the name implies, a magnificent wine with luscious dark berry fruits and flavours of black cherries, incredibly smooth with a long satisfying finish. 29.95 23. Colombo & Fille, Cotes du Rhone Rouge Rhone, France A crunchy, bright wine, packed with red fruit characters, well-rounded tannins and balanced acidity. 24. Chalk Ridge Syrah, Cooper's Creek 29.95 (99% Syrah, 1 % Viognier) Hawkes Bay, New Zealand This wine demonstrates the essence of Hawkes Bay Syrah: masses of black fruits, a touch of pepper, some meatiness and lovely savoury oak. Beautifully structured palate, medium to full bodied with masses of fruit mid-palate and a long finish. 25. Bourgogne Pinot Noir 33.95 Alain Michelot, Burgundy, France A Bourgogne Rouge of unusual depth and intensity, with perfumed blackberry/black cherry fruit, medium-full body, and a long floral finish. 36.95 Chateau Palais Cardinal St Emilion, Bordeaux, France A particularly sumptuous Saint Emilion, showing all the ripeness of a fine vintage, but lifted by a seam of freshness. Red berry and plum fruit meet cedary spice in a wine of superb balance and length.

## 35. Volnay Vieille Vignes 2009 Jean Marc Bouley 50.00 Burgundy, France

Aromatic with nots of roasted coffee and zingy red currant, this medium bodied Volnay is a bit more structured with its impressive concentration and more pronounced structure. But time will make this round, velvety and layered.

### 36. Manoir de Gay 2007 Pomerol, Bordeaux, France

An exceptional wine from this leading estate, this is intense and perfumed, with rich aromas of plums, roasted coffee and meat. The mouthfeel is generous but dynamic, with excellent balance allowing the complex range of flavours to shine.

# 37. Nuits St Georges Vieille Vignes 2009 Jean-Marc Bouley, Burgundy, France Sleek, aromatic Burgundy with the typical blackberry and spice character of Nuits. Full in the mouth yet beautifully poised, this wine shows the depth and precision that come from old vines.

## 38. Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 60.00 2009 Masi, Veneto, Italy

Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla.

## 39. Chateau d'Angludet 2006 60.00Margaux, Bordeaux, FranceDensely concentrated ripeness, some florality, very

good middle sweetness, robust quite gamey finish.

### 40. Tignanello 2001 Antinori, Toscana, Italy

A powerful Tignanello, the 2011 offers a combination of ripe, dark fruit and an underlying freshness, reflecting the vintage conditions. Plum cherries mingle with mint and liquorice, creating a vivid, harmonious balance from the first impression.

Meerlust Etate Rubicon 99.95 South Africa 2012 Intense dark fruit juiciness coming from a renowned Cabernet Sauvignon vintage. 45. Chateau Angludet 99.95 Margaux, Bordeaux, France Aromas of sweet bright fruit jump out of the glass, silky velvety red berry notes with good, supple richness. Cuvee Boisrenard Chateauneuf-du-Pape 124.95 Domaine de Beaurenard France Lush and open-knit but energetic, offering intense red and dark berry flavours. Shows impressive power
