Ruby red in colour with aromas of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Full-bodied with flavours of damsons and liquorice, with a hint of spice on the finish. 24.95

35. Volnay 'Clos de Chenes' Premier Cru
Maison Roche De Bellene 2012
Burgundy, France
From one of Volnay's most notable Premier Cru vineyards, perfectly suited for growing Pinot Noir, and delivering expressive wines with lithe tannin, rich fruit and plenty of poise and sophistication. This is an exceptional wine from a winemaker with a burgeoning reputation, full of dark fruit and soft, fragrant spice, with the backbone required to keep it all pinned neatly together.
36. Manoir de Gay 2007
Pomerol, Bordeaux, France
An exceptional wine from this leading estate, this is intense and perfumed, with rich aromas of plums, roasted coffee and meat. The mouthfeel is generous but dynamic, with excellent balance allowing the complex range of flavours to shine.
37. Nuits St Georges Vieille Vignes 2009
Jean-Marc Bouley, Burgundy, France
Sleek, aromatic Burgundy with the typical blackberry and spice character of Nuits. Full in the mouth yet beautifully poised, this wine shows the depth and precision that come from old vines.
38. Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2009 Masi, Veneto, Italy
Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla.
39. Chateau Musar 2009
Lebanon
The wine that put modern Lebanese viticulture on the map, made from spicy Carignan and Cinsault and full-blooded purple-fruited Cabernet Sauvignon. The individual wines are blended two years after harvest, before a further 12 months in barrel and four years in bottles, deep in the Musar cellars develops the trademark elegance and sophisticated complexity.

40. Jean-Marc Brocard, Chablis Premier Cru
Butteaux, Burgundy 2014 79.95
It's aged in 100% old oak so there is deeper colour here and a touch more spice on the nose. The palate is full and expansive with some tropical fruit riffs and candied lemon driving the spectrum, albeit it remains precise with the requisite amount of minerality and bright acidity to keep it balanced.
41. Pinot Noir, Domaine de Valmoissne
Louis Latour 44.95
Harmonious with ripe tannins and balanced acidity. It is medium bodied with rich summer pudding fruit flavours and a long silky finish.
42. Rioja Reserva, Marques de Murrieta
Spain 2010 74.95
Intense balsamic notes of incense, smoked meat, leather, fennel and cherries, which make it feel very Rioja. The palate is medium-bodied, balanced, with excellent acidity and freshness. A serious vintage of Murrieta Reserva that represents great balance between tradition and modernity.
43. Meerlust Estate Rubicon
South Africa 2012 99.95
Intense dark fruit juiciness coming from a renowned Cabernet Sauvignon vintage
44. Cuvee Boisenard Chateneauf-du Pape
Domaine de Beurenard, France 124.95
Lush and open –knit, but energetic, offering intense red and dark berry flavours. Shows impressive power and energy on the long, floral-dominated finish.
